

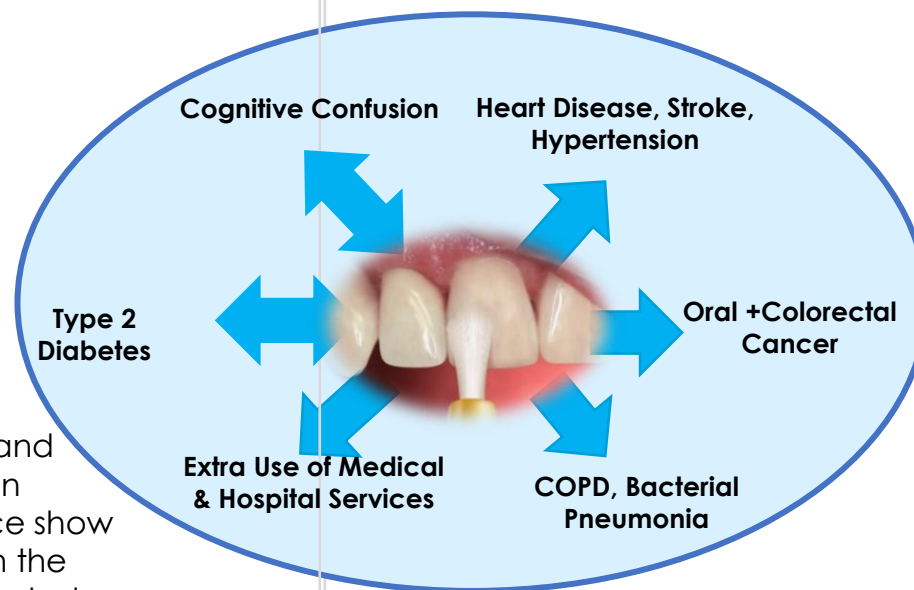
Oral health is health
